TUITION GUIDE & POLICIES

Registration: Annual Registration fee of \$40.00 per family. (Non-refundable)

The registration fee and tuition are due at the time of enrollment.

Student enrollment officially closes Jan.18, 2020.

Enroll early to ensure best class selection. Limited class sizes.

Performing Arts registration by audition only.

<u>Tuition Payment:</u> All classes meet 32 times in the dance year. We divide the full year tuition in to 9 monthly payments. Tuition fees will be paid monthly or may be paid in full at the start of the 2019/20 dance year. We also offer automatic credit card billing. Tuition is due at the beginning of each month.

Tuition:

Creative Dance and Mommy & Me classes are charged at \$52.00 per month

30 minute classes are charged at \$42.00 per month

45 minute classes are charged at \$59.00 per month

60 minute classes are charged at \$66.00 per month

75 minute classes are charged at \$73.00 per month

90 minute classes are charged at \$77.00 per month

Adult classes are \$12 per class, or \$6 per class for Fitness via Punch Cards.

<u>Costumes & Recital Fee:</u> All classes will conclude with a Spring Recital performance.

Each student will need to purchase one costume per class to be received in the spring.

Creative Dance & Mommy and Me: \$71

Recreational Classes: \$81

Pre-Performing Arts & Performing Arts: \$91

\$50.00 will be billed in November for the non-refundable costume deposit.*

The remaining costume balance will be billed in February 2020.*

*Pre-Performing Arts & Performing Arts deposit billed in October & balance in January.

All families will be charged a recital fee of \$25 in January, which will cover a downloadable link to the digital recording of the recital! (no more DVDs to purchase for \$30!)

Discounts:

A \$15 discount applies to the 3rd class taken in any one family.

A \$18 discount applies to the 4th and subsequent classes taken in any one family.

Discounts are applied to the classes of shorter duration first.

Adult classes do not qualify for any discounts.

<u>Refunds & Withdrawals:</u> Refunds will not be given after attending 1 week of scheduled classes. No refunds or credits are given for any remaining classes to be held within the month of your withdrawal. Please notify PSOD via email or phone regarding withdrawals.

Terms and conditions for the payment of fees:

- 1. All bills are due and payable within 15 days of receipt.
- 2. Any outstanding bills, registration, and tuition fees must be paid before a dancer may attend class at the beginning of each month, except where a payment plan has been agreed to with Prairie School of Dance.
- 3. Costumes must be paid in full before they may be taken home, unless arrangements have been made with Prairie School of Dance.
- $4. \ A\ 5\%$ administration fee will be applied to all outstanding bills where a payment plan is not in place.


Dress Code
